### **ABOUT CAMP MUSART**

Camp MusArt is LAMusArt's five-week Musical Theatre focused enrichment program for students ages 7 to 16 that work together that combines music, visual arts, dance and drama disciplines to produce a full-length musical performance in a professional venue.

### **POSITION DESCRIPTION**

The Camp MusArt Visual Arts Lead will serve as the Art Instructor and Prop/Set Designer for LAMusArt's 2026 Summer Production of Annie Jr. The Visual Arts Lead will work in collaborations with our Drama Director, Dance Lead, and Music Lead to produce the full production of the selected musical. The Art Lead will be responsible for leading four (4) classes per day (one hour and fifteen minutes each) introducing students to varying of visual arts technique and appreciation while incorporating making necessary props for the show.

### **PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Foster a safe, inclusive, and engaging learning environment where all students feel valued and motivated to succeed. Catered to the student's skill level and age group. Encourage creative expression, teamwork, and problem-solving through exercises and activities.
- Design, coordinate, and implement standards-aligned Visual Arts curriculum that introduces students ages 7–16 to foundational artistic concepts, art history, and diverse artistic practices while fostering creative expression and critical thinking.
- Produce all required prop and set pieces needed for the show by the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> week of Camp.
- Supervise student during class times, rehearsals, half of the student's lunch break and at the off-site venue culminating performance.
- Maintain communication with Camp Coordinator & Programs Manger regarding student progress and/or behavior issues.
- Collaborate with other faculty and staff plan and organize rehearsals, performances, and special events, as needed.
