## CLASS SCHEDULE

### REGISTRATION

You may register for classes in person at our office. Registration involves the completion of an enrollment form, the payment of a non-refundable registration fee, and the first month's tuition.

**Our school year is September 1 through August 31.** The annual registration fee (\$50) is per family on 9/1 of each year as follows: For initial registrations after November 30, the fees will be pro-rated.

### PAYMENT

Tuition is charged to each student on the first day of each month for the number of classes scheduled to be held during the month. The full monthly tuition must be paid in full whether or not all classes are attended. Your payment reserves the class spot for the month. All tuition and fees for the current month are due and payable on the first business day of the month.

**A late fee of \$25.00 will be charged for current month tuition and fees that have not yet been paid in full by the 5th day of the month.**

If all charges are not paid by the 6th day of the month, students will not be allowed to continue classes until both the outstanding and current month balances are paid in full. Partial payments are not accepted.

Cash, checks, money orders, Visa, MasterCard and Discover are accepted. There is a \$50.00 charge for all returned checks.

### MUSIC LESSONS

#### Individual Music Instruction

Individual music instruction is available to children age 7 and older and to adults. We provide instruction in piano, guitar, violin, viola, cello, woodwinds, drums, trumpet, saxophone and voice. Instruction is provided at beginning, intermediate, and advanced levels.

Students must provide their own instruments for lessons and at-home practice. (Pianos are provided for lessons.) Lessons are 30 minutes in length and are held once per week. Classes are held Mondays through Thursdays from 3 pm to 8 pm and on Saturdays from 8 am to 4 pm, based on availability.

### SCHOLARSHIPS

LAMusArt offers a limited amount of scholarships to students (ages 4-17) for the 2019 – 2020 school year (September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2020) based on a combination of financial need, interest in the arts, and/ or demonstrated musical or artistic skills.

All Scholarship and financial aid recipients, including art, dance and drama students, are required to audition for placement in one of our performing ensembles; Choir, Jazz Ensemble, Mariachi, Youth Orchestra. If selected to participate in one of the ensembles, students will be required to attend weekly rehearsals and participate fully in recitals and performances. Failure to maintain excellent attendance and to participate in performance activities will forfeit the scholarship or financial aid
